Traffic

Door-to-Door Sales

All solicitors are required by law to obtain a permit to canvas our neighborhood. For your safety, ask for their permit to determine if they are connected to a legitimate company. "No Solicitation" markers on our entrance signs would limit home business and fundraisers such as Avon and the Girl Scouts. Neighbors bothered by salespeople should consider posting signs found at local hardware stores.
